## Code of Conduct

Individuals are responsible to abide by the following while on our campus. Group leaders are accountable to FDM Staff for their group's adherence to these guidelines. We reserve the right to ask any group member, or group, to leave the premises, without a refund, if found to be in violation of this code.

- Parents are responsible for their children's behavior and must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- There is no use of cooking implements in the sleeping or meeting rooms; this includes but is not limited to hot plates, microwaves, chafing dishes, or camp stoves.
- There is no use of candles in the meeting rooms or Guest Houses.
- Abusive, offensive or profane language will not be tolerated. This specifically includes misuse of the Lord's name.
- Smoking and/or the use of tobacco products are not permitted. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, weapons, and fireworks are prohibited from the grounds.
- Advocating, condoning or practicing sexual immorality or homosexuality is not permitted. This prohibits the sharing of a room by unrelated persons of the opposite sex.
- Guests are to refrain from excessive noise between the hours of 11:00 pm and 7:30 am.
- Guests are to be dressed in modest apparel.
- Tampering with the fire alarms and related equipment except in the case of a true emergency is prohibited.
- Guests may not place wet items, such as towels and bathing suits, inside dresser drawers in the guest room. Please hang these items up to dry.
- Trash is to be properly disposed of in trash receptacles.
- Guests may not be on the grounds of Day Camp Sunshine when it is in session, or interfere with DCS operations in any way.
- Guests may not enter the first and second floors of the Youth Center Building at any time. These floors are utilized solely by Sunshine Preschool & Infant Care. The basement level/gymnasium may not be accessed or used by guests when the Preschool is in session, Monday – Friday, 7am – 6pm, year round.
- The swimming pools are only to be used during regular hours and only when a lifeguard employed by Fellowship Deaconry Ministries is on duty.
- For the protection of our guests and staff, guests are strictly prohibited from entering the Ropes Course area, attempting to climb the Ropes Course equipment, or using the Ropes Course equipment in any way, unless they have obtained permission from the Outdoor Adventure Activities Manager AND are under the supervision of a certified instructor from FDM, or an FDM approved certified instructor. Because of the inherent potential danger of using the Swimming Pool and Ropes Course and associated equipment, without the appropriate supervision and approval, anyone found in violation of this rule will be asked to leave immediately. If the guest is a member of the group, the entire group will be asked to leave. No refund will be issued.
